



The vocabulary presented below appeared in New English File Upper-intermediate, Unit 2a. I propose further vocabulary practice according to the procedure:

- print and cut the table – you will need one set per pair of students,
- ask the students to match the words with their definitions,
- check answers with the whole group,
- ask each student to draw one or two words and make sentences with them; the sentences are later presented to the whole group,
- you may prepare one copy of the table below for each student to give them after the exercise – they will have the answers and a list of words to learn.

unwillingness	being hesitant or reluctant
heritage	something that comes or belongs to one by reason of birth
achieve	perform or carry out with success; accomplish
climate	the weather averaged over a long period
attitude	a state of mind or a feeling
multi-ethnic	relating to, or including several ethnic groups
wrongs	unjust or injurious acts
